When choosing the recipient for the scholarship, the Cattlewomen put just as much emphasis on the application as on the interview. Please type your application and personal essay, paying close attention to spelling and grammar. You may use any computer program. The neatness and completeness of your application will be evaluated. The more information you can give us, the easier it will be for us to evaluate your application.

The application asks for information regarding your FFA achievements. You may include or substitute 4-H or other personal agriculture experiences. Please include a one (no more than two) page essay including your agriculture accomplishments, educational goals, and career objectives.

- Include which school you have chosen to attend, what your major will be, and briefly explain why you have made these choices.
- We are also asking for two letters of recommendation to be included with your application.
- Please include your current overall GPA along with your GPA in agriculture classes. It is also necessary to include your official high school transcript.
- The deadline to submit your application is March 15th.

We have included these guidelines to aid you in filling out and presenting an application that is respectable and informative.

- How would this award help you with your plans for the future?

Please include up to two letters of recommendation with your application and a copy of your transcripts.
