The Placer-Nevada Cattlewomen offers a \$1000 University Scholarship. As a past recipient of a PNCW scholarship, you are eligible to apply. The deadline to submit your application is March 1st. Please read and follow these guidelines when filling out your application. Following these guidelines will greatly enhance your chances of becoming a successful applicant.

Please type your essay, paying close attention to spelling and grammar. The neatness and completeness of your application will be evaluated. The more information you can give us, the easier it will be to evaluate your application. The application asks for information regarding your college/university experience and your involvement in the agriculture industry.

Please include a one (no more than two) page essay including your agriculture accomplishments, educational goals, career objectives, and briefly explain why you have made these choices. We are also asking for up to two letters of recommendation to be included with your application.

Please include your current overall GPA along with your GPA in Agriculture classes. It is also necessary to include your current college transcript. We may conduct a phone interview of prospective applicants before choosing a recipient. Be prepared to answer questions on Agriculture related topics. It would also be helpful to know about our organization.

We have provided these guidelines to aid you in filling out and presenting an application that is respectable and informative.
